



So you've got a story to tell...maybe it's a personal experience, maybe it's an expose on your favourite paranormal topic, or maybe it's a how-to guide for paranormal investigation. Whatever it is, we're interested in reading it and we'd like the opportunity to publish your work on Paranormal People.

Anyone wishing to have their written work reviewed for potential publication, should submit a query through the website contact form, detailing what the piece is about, how long it is and your terms for publication*. (Do not send the work itself through the form, in part or in whole)

Upon acceptance of your idea, story or article, we will forward an email indicating our copyright and author credit policy, and requesting a preformatted copy of the work.

If this sounds like something you would be interested in, please keep reading for a detailed list of submission guidelines.

- Your piece **MUST** pertain to the Paranormal in some way.
- Format your document in MS Word or equivalent, as you would like it to appear on the website. (i.e. paragraph breaks etc.)
- Use only Verdana 11pt black font
- Generally speaking, we will only accept documents between 750 and 1200 words in length, though there may be exceptions made
- If there are specific images or media to be included, do not embed them in the document, keep them separate with a place marker in the document where you would like them to appear (example: [place picture 3 here])
- Include a short bio about yourself, and indicate how you would like your name to appear (you may use a pseudonym if you wish)
- Profanity, racism, religious or political intolerance and/or depictions of criminal/violent acts will not be published**

Some quick tips to ensure your article is published as you intend.

- Fact check, fact check, fact check: Paranormal People will not publish libellous, untrue or questionable material or information, if your work falls in one of those categories it will not be published.**
- Write for your readers and not for search engines (let us worry about keywords)
- Choose topics that are off the beaten path (we can only publish so many pieces about orbs)
- Spell check, spell check, spell check; while we will edit your article for small, infrequent errors, we will return your piece only once for editorial revision. If the next submission is not correct, we will not continue with your piece.
- We will gladly accept multiple submissions from one author, but each piece will be dealt with independently.
